

Construction | Overview

The Construction industry in Ireland bounced back with a bang post-Covid. It was one of the first sectors to open back up and demand for staff has returned to pre-pandemic levels. In addition, the skills shortage has been exacerbated due to the outflow of skilled labour to more 'open' construction markets such as the UK during the crisis.

Part of the industry, in particular consultancies, adapted to the new reality and people are working remotely: CAD/BIM/REVIT Technicians, Design Engineers, Quantity Surveyors and Structural Engineers among others.

Looking ahead, the biggest challenge for the sector is finding the right talent. We see skills shortages in Quantity Surveying, Site and Project Engineers, Architects, Civil Engineers, Planners and HSE Advisors for Dublin and around Ireland. We are in a 'candidate-led' market that has driven up salaries. How are companies addressing this problem?

Employers are doing their best to retain their staff and hire new people. We are noticing an increase in counteroffers and an enhancement of benefits packages. Salaries are continuing to rise but at a slower pace. Now, a common way to attract talent is to improve the the overall package (car allowance, pension, health care, bonus, etc) and also non-financial benefits such as improved flexible working terms.

Other measures taken to address the shortage are to 1) relocate professionals to Ireland from abroad, 2) attract international talent to Ireland and 3) use graduate/apprenticeship programs. An added difficulty here is that the shortage of housing options and inflated rents and purchase prices, particularly in Dublin, can make people think twice about relocating.

Comparing salary levels around Ireland, we see higher salaries being achieved in Dublin compared to the rest of the country. However, there is evidence to suggest that the gap is closing.
